## **HEALTH DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEE GRADUATES FROM NATIONAL HEALTH LEADERSHIP PROGRAM**

The Martin County Health Department is proud to announce the recent graduation of Angeline DeWald from the Environmental Health Public Leadership Institute (EPHLI).

The EPHLI program is funded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and is designed to support the professional development and enhance the leadership capabilities of environmental health practitioners. Each year, approximately 30 candidates are chosen from around the country to participate in the year long program.

Dewald, an Environmental Health Specialist, graduated from the program in February during a ceremony held at the CDC headquarters in Atlanta.
