FREE IMMUNIZATION CLINIC FOR STUDENTS ENTERING 7TH GRADE

Health Department to offer the Tdap and Meningitis vaccines

The Martin County Health Department will host an immunization clinic for students entering the 7th grade. State regulation requires students who are entering 7th grade to receive a **Tdap booster** (Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis). A parent must be present in order for their child to receive the vaccine.

In addition, the Health Department will offer the **Meningococcal (Meningitis) vaccine**. Many colleges now require the vaccine as part of the admission process. The vaccine is recommended for middle school students, but is not required for school entry. The vaccine is free for students 18 years old and younger. Cost is \$100 for students 19 years and older.
