THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO OFFER FREE HIV TESTING

In support of **National HIV Testing Day**, the Martin County Health Department will offer free HIV testing and education at two upcoming events.

It is estimated that someone in the United States becomes infected with HIV every nine and a half minutes.

Early HIV diagnosis is critical, so people who are infected can fully benefit from life-saving treatments. Currently, almost 40 percent of people with HIV are not diagnosed until they have already developed AIDS. That can be up to 10 years after they first became infected with HIV. Finding out early is the first step to stopping the spread and improving health.
