**THE H1N1 VACCINE NOW AVAILABLE TO EVERYONE  
OVER THE AGE OF 6 MONTHS**

If you want to get the H1N1 vaccine, now is your chance. The Health Department will host an H1N1 vaccination clinic this Saturday morning at their Stuart clinic.

The vaccine will be offered for free on a first come first served basis, while supplies last. Lines are expected. If you have difficulty standing, you are encouraged to bring a lawn chair for comfort.

Children nine years old and younger who already received their first dose of the vaccine **at least 21 days ago** are encouraged to return for a booster to provide maximum coverage against the virus.
