**THE H1N1 VACCINE TO BE OFFERED TO ANYONE  
OVER THE AGE OF 6 MONTHS**

*The Health Department to host a public clinic on Saturday, December 12*

With supplies of the H1N1 vaccine rising, The Martin County Health Department will now offer the vaccine to anyone over the age of 6 months.

An H1N1 vaccination clinic will be held on **Saturday, December 12** from **9:00 am to 1:00 pm** at the **Martin County Health Department, 3441 SE Willoughby Blvd, Stuart**. Vaccinations are voluntary and are offered on a first come first served basis, while supply lasts.

"We are pleased that we are now able to offer the H1N1 vaccine to anyone who would like it," said Mark Chittum, Administrator for the Martin County Health Department. "We hope people will take this opportunity to get vaccinated, as well as continue to practice good hygiene to prevent the spread of flu."

Children nine years old and younger who already received their first dose of the vaccine at **least 21 days ago** are encouraged to come back for their booster dose to provide maximum coverage against the virus.
